NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

Races will be conducted under the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 (RRS). All competitors shall be bound by these rules and the Sailing Instructions issued by GRYC.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The race will be open to entries from all Sailability classes. At least 6 boats of a class are required to constitute a Division. Boats of a similar Yardstick may be grouped together.

2.2 All entries must be received by 1000 Sunday 20 January 2019.

3. FEES

Entry Fee — \$5

All nomination fees are inclusive of GST.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5. COURSES

A series of short-course races will be conducted adjacent to the Goolwa Regatta Yacht Club, and will be set on the day to be most appropriate for the weather conditions.

7. SCORING

A boat's series score will be the total of all her race scores.

8. TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded to 1st and 2nd in each division with 6 starters. 3rd place will be awarded if there are at least 9 starters in a division.

The Simon Thiele Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the boat in any division with the lowest score.

If there is a tie, it will be resolved by using the lowest total times, adjusted by VYC Yardstick.

Trophies and sponsors prizes will be presented at the GRYC at 1330 hrs.

9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

10. INSURANCE

Each participating boat must be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover \$2 million per incident or the equivalent..
