1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The Organising Authority will be the Goolwa Regatta Yacht Club (GRYC).

2. LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION

The Marina Challenge will be conducted in the Hindmarsh Island residential lagoons over 2 heats.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The regatta is open to all yachts that are recognized as Trailable Yachts by GRYC.

GRYC Mixed Fleet Ratings (MFR's) will be applied or as otherwise determined by the Race Committee.

The use of spinnakers is not permitted.

Competitors must be members of an Australian Sailing affiliated club.

Eligible yachts may enter by completing the attached form and together with the required fee either, lodge it in person at GRYC or scan and email it to:

4. RACE SCHEDULE

Date of Race: Saturday 18th January 2020

Briefing at GRYC: at 12:00 Warning signal: 12:58 First start: 13:00

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The 2020-2021 GRYC Sailing Instructions (effective 1 October 2020) will apply to this event and they can be found on the GRYC website under the "Racing Tab".

6. COURSE

Two timed runs through the residential canal development on Hindmarsh Island known as Barkers, Sturt, Strangways and Hutchinson's Lagoons.

When all boats have completed the first run through the lagoons, they shall return to the starting area for the second timed run.

At the briefing competitors will be given course diagrams, positions of start and finish lines, and will be allocated start times at two minute intervals. The direction of the course will be announced at the briefing.

7. THE START

The first warning signal will be at approximately 12:58

2 minutes prior to the first starting signalWarning signal2 sound signalsAt 0 minutesFirst starting signal1 sound signalAt 2 minute intervalsSubsequent starting signals for each boat1 sound signal

The warning signal for the first boat in the second run will be at approximately 14:00 hrs.

Starting Penalties: Rule 30.3 shall be in place.

8. OVERTAKING

Once a yacht that was clear astern obtains an overlap (either to leeward OR windward) the yacht ahead must give the overlapping yacht room to overtake.

9. THE FINISH

The finish line will be between two blue flags.

10. SCORING

The scoring system will be based on the aggregate corrected time for the two runs.

11. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded for first and second yachts.

12. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 000 (ten million) per incident or the equivalent.

13. DISCLAIMER

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organising Authority will not be liable liability for any personal injury or death, or property damage sustained or caused in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
